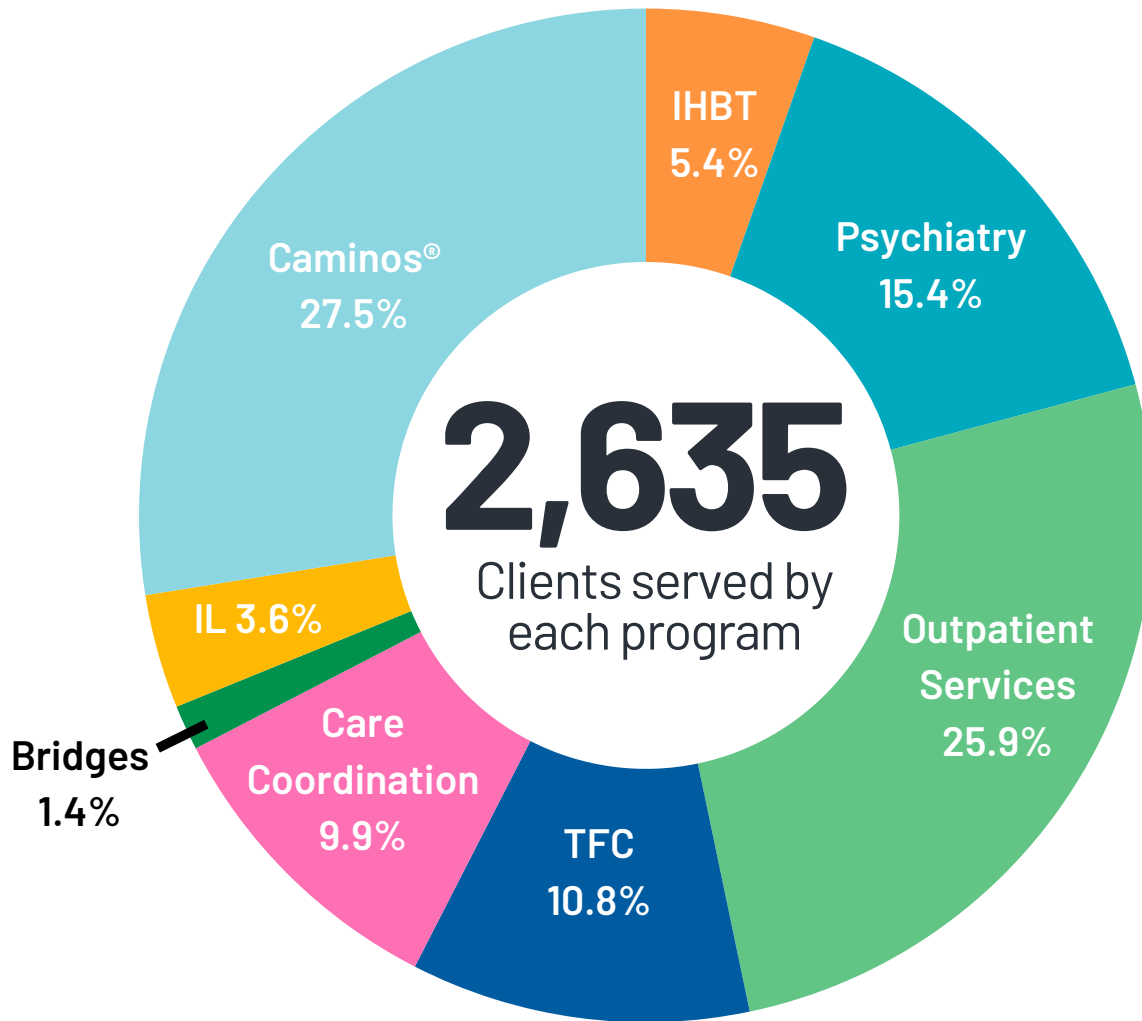
Who We Are

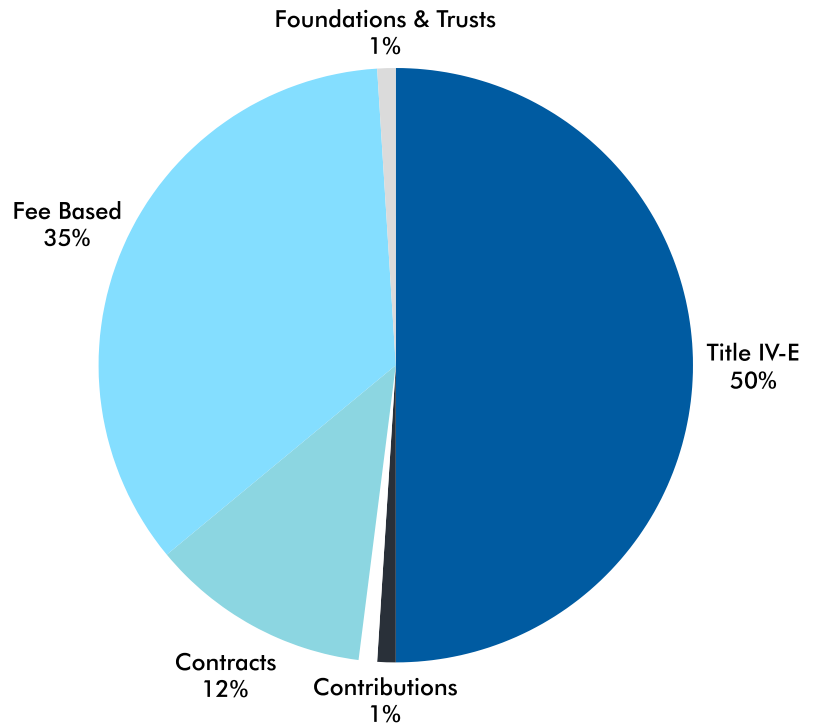
